

The Direct Tap team is proud to partner with our friends at the Canadian Brewing Awards this year to offer out logistics services to all participating breweries & cideries sending their product to the CBAC for judging.

The competition is open to all Canadian owned commercial brewers whose products are produced and packaged in Canada. You may submit entries in as many categories as you like (limit 12 total), but each brand may be entered in only one category.

**For breweries & cideries in the Lower Mainland/Island:**

Products must be delivered to Direct Tap's Lower Mainland warehouse  
#40 – 8385 Fraser Street, Vancouver BC  
No later than **Friday, March 9<sup>th</sup> 2018**

**For breweries & cideries in the Interior:**

Products must be delivered to Direct Tap's Interior warehouse  
#103 – 13415 Lakeshore Drive, Summerland BC  
No later than **Monday, March 5<sup>th</sup> 2018**

Product will leave Direct Tap on **Tuesday, March 13<sup>th</sup> 2018** and will arrive in Halifax via cold climate-controlled shipment no later than **March 23<sup>rd</sup>**

**Shipping Costs**

Current Direct Tap partners: \$30/case

Non-Direct Tap partners: \$40/case

**Procedure**

1. Go to [entries.canadianbrewingawards.com](http://entries.canadianbrewingawards.com) to complete your entry form. Please ensure you complete the form based on how you want the company and brand names to appear on your award
2. Send six bottles/cans of each beer/cider entered. Ensure all boxes are labelled with **COMPANY NAME, PRODUCT NAME and CATEGORY NAME**. Companies submitting non-pasteurized products are encouraged to ship using overnight delivery (not for Saturday or Sunday delivery). The Canadian Brewing Awards will not accept beer or cider in keg format.
3. It is your responsibility to ensure all beers and cider are packed tightly in shipping boxes to avoid breakage. We strongly suggest you wrap each bottle securely in bubble wrap. All beer/ciders received will immediately be refrigerated and categorized for the competition. If entering more than one product, you may ship them together, however, please separate the samples by category within the package and label accordingly.
